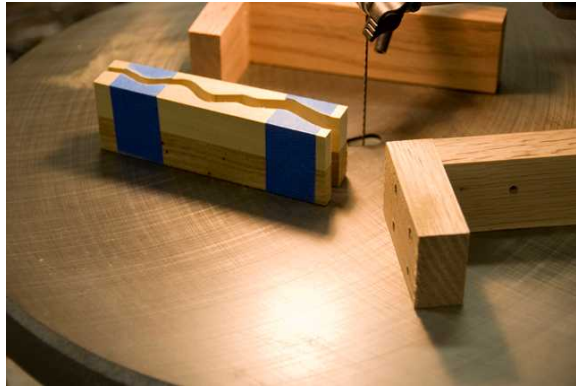




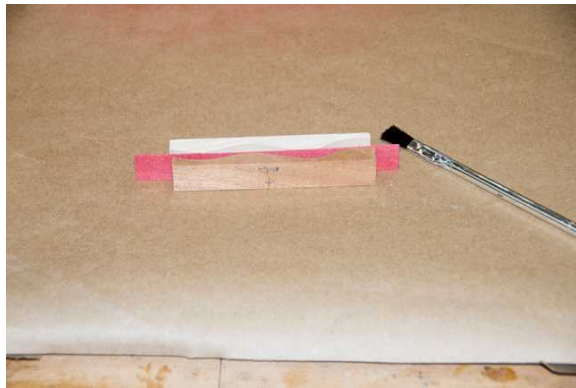
Pic 1: Cutting a curve using L-shaped push blocks



Pic 2: A cut stacked pair



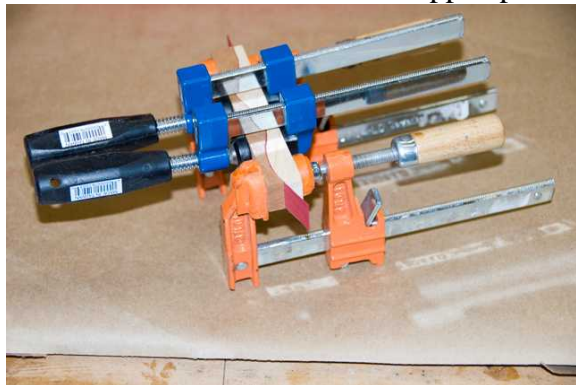
Pic 3: Swapping parts from a cut pair

Pic 9: Restacking blanks, aligning the previous cut line



Pic 10: Blanks restacked and taped for the 2<sup>nd</sup> cut



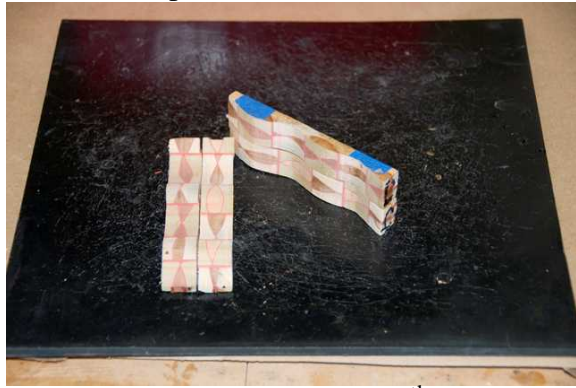
Pic 11: Inside of blanks after 2<sup>nd</sup> cut



Pic 12: Two pairs (4 woods) after 2<sup>nd</sup> cut



Pic 13: Swapping blanks between pairs gets 2 blanks containing all 4 woods

Pic 15: Final set of 4 blanks, each containing a mix of all 4 woods
