

This Note is an update from your Club Librarian ([librarian@WNTX.org](mailto:librarian@WNTX.org)) to all Club Members.

The Library has switched from the old card system for accounting of the library Books and Videos to a computer system.

There are a few policies added to the Library Check-out system:

1. You will only be able to check-out 4 Books and Videos at any given time.

2. The Check-out length of time is 60 days.

3. To check out a book or video you must meet the following:

Be a Member of the WNTX Club.

Fill out a card with the Following:

Full Name.

E-mail Address

Phone Number that I can text to.

The cards to fill out are available at the librarian's desk in the back of the meeting room.

- A list of Books and Videos for Check-out will be available on line on our web site at ([WNTX.org](http://WNTX.org)) and at each meeting on the Library table. A printed list will also be available on the Library table during the Club meetings.
- Take special Note that each Book/Video has a designated ID #. This number matches an inventory number in the computer system.
- To RETURN Books and Videos, just place them in the RETURN box on the library table.

The Club has built a large library and it was built by the past librarians and Club Members. To be the Librarian of such a knowledge base is indeed a privilege. I want to share this Knowledge base with everyone in the Club. So, Peruse the list of Books and Videos check them out and enjoy.

## President's Notes for September, 2021

**Practice does not make perfect!**

What???????

That's right. Practice makes permanent, so make sure you are practicing good technique when you are turning something.

In 2018 I took a week-long class with Stuart Batty at Craft Supplies in Provo. Following that class I found turning much easier and I was getting better results. Then I started to drift away from what Stuart taught me and back toward the familiar ways that had produced results that drove me to Stuart in the first place. Finally, I acknowledged that I was practicing poor technique and decided to get a tune-up. I spoke to Stuart and Jeri Briseppierre (co-owner of Woodworkers Emporium in Las Vegas) at SWAT about the September week-long class Stuart was teaching. Unfortunately, the class was full, and another was not scheduled. Fortune smiled on me and someone dropped out the following week and with just 5 days' notice I was off to Las Vegas for another week of training. By the end of the day Friday I was tired, but convinced my technique was sound again.

Maybe some people only need to be taught how to do something once, and they never drift from that, but many of us need repetitive learning with skilled guidance. I am certainly that way, and the sooner I acknowledge that I need help, the sooner I improve. I went to class willing to discard the familiar things that were not serving me well, and practice (and, hopefully make permanent) things that would serve me well.

Practice makes permanent, so make sure you practice doing the right things the right way. Get help! No one is born with complete and natural knowledge of how to turn so find someone skilled and get their help. With time, your results are bound to improve!

One last note: as many of you know we lost long time member Bill Burney a few months ago. We will be holding a sale of many of Bill's tools on Friday, 9/24, and Saturday, 9/25. We will be sending out a flier with details shortly. Please attend if at all possible. Bill had lots of tools and it will help his widow, Pat.



## Beads of Courage Program

This program is designed to support, strengthen and encourage children and families coping with serious illness. The program lets the children tell their story using colorful beads as meaningful symbols that commemorates milestones they have achieved along their treatment path. The average child gets 500 beads. The Woodturners of North Texas is taking on the challenge again this year.

## Requirements

The lidded box/bowl interior diameter should be 6" (5" minimum diameter, 6" depth, 4" minimum). The lid should have a finial/knob that is easy for a child to grasp and not too elaborate. The 'Beads of Courage' logo bead to be placed inside or outside will be available at the meeting or can be mailed to you upon request. The "Beads of Courage" inscription can also be engraved or burned in the lid and can be placed inside or outside of the lid (no political or religious undertones are accepted). Customarily your box or bowl will be taken to SWAT and displayed along with the others from the club. Your thanks is knowing a very ill child is getting something that will help them through difficult times.
